- For clinical postings arrangements, **Dr. Madhavi Maliwad**, for Ophthalmology and Otorhinolaryngology **Dr. Shailesh Rathod** for surgery and allied branches and **Dr. Brajendra Kumar Sir**, HOD, Dept. of Medicine for medicine and allied branches will be in charge with the knowledge of the Dean.
- After each clinical posting, all respective departments will conduct a **ward ending examination** and results will be submitted with HOD signature in PDF files to the student section of college with carbon copy to the Dean Sir. No separate intimation will be given to the students for ward examination, they have to coordinate with the respective department
- No vacation will be provided to the students as we have to complete the clinical postings as per NMC guidelines and taking into consideration the next NMC inspection.
- At most precautions are taken in framing the clinical postings time table; changes can be done as per the need or situation.
- In Clinical Posting –
 - 09.00 am to 10.00 am – History of patient as per allotted bed to student/s
 - 10.00 am to 11.00 am – Presentation of case by student to the clinical batch and faculty.
 - 11.00 am to 11.50 am – Discussion on case with the students by faculty.
- Being split campus all the faculties and students are directed to see their email regularly. It is difficult to meet at frequent interval and dispatch hard copy of the circular individually.

- Attendance: Theory 75% and Practical 80% attendance also for Clinical postings 80% attendance is must for the students to be eligible for appearing in SGG University Examinations.






